

**Candidates Committee Report
Presbytery of Southwest FL
September 13, 2014**

I. Recommendations to the Presbytery

- 1) The CFM Committee recommends the Presbytery to remove Chuck Anderson from the roles as a Candidate per Chuck's request.**

- 2) The CFM Committee recommends the Presbytery to receive Justin Chappell as a Candidate of the SWFL Presbytery.**

Note: Justin Chappell has only been a member of Cornerstone Presbyterian Church since June. This means he has not been a member for the required six months (BCO 18-2). However, the BCO provides an exception to this rule in cases deemed extraordinary by the Presbytery (BCO 18-2). The session of Cornerstone provided the following rationale as to why Justin's case is extraordinary:

The Session recognizes that Justin has not yet been a member of Cornerstone for six months, however we believe Justin's case should be considered "extraordinary" per BCO 18-2 in light of his long-term ministry relationship with our Pastor Phil Woods (from January 2011 through May 2014), including Justin's already having been under care of the Mid-America Presbytery of the EPC during his final year at Covenant Seminary in St. Louis. We therefore have ample, first-hand evidence of his gifts and call and commitment to the church and the ministry through the testimony of our Pastor and others at City Church in St. Louis. We note that Justin has basically already completed the requirements of an internship with our own Pastor as his mentor while at City Church in St. Louis. For these reasons the Session believes that Justin's case should be considered "extraordinary" under BCO 18.2.

- 3) The CFM Committee recommends the Presbytery to bring Justin Chappell on as an intern.**

II. Quarterly Intern Reports

Ardon, Willy: has begun a Spanish bible-study at Redeemer Presbyterian church in Riverview. He teaches weekly there and also preaches monthly at a homeless ministry outreach at Holy Trinity Presbyterian Church.

Bennet, Rick: Is near the end of his internship. He is considering opportunities in academics.

Glandon, Heath: Heath's mentor reports that Heath's internship is effectively on hold as Heath gives attention to other demands on his time.

Krause, Jeff: continues at Auburn Road in his internship. He is near completion and plans to meet with the candidates committee at their October meeting.

The committee's next meeting is tentatively set for Thursday, October 16, 2014 at Redeemer in Riverview, at 9:15am. Those seeking to meet with the committee for candidacy or internship purposes need to submit all requirements ten days in advance of this meeting.

Those seeking to come under care are responsible for ensuring that they know the dates and location of the committee meeting and are responsible for knowing what they must submit in order to be examined.
