

REPORT OF COMMISSION TO INSTALL

Report of the Commission to install Rev. Brandon Lutz as Assistant Pastor of Church of the Redeemer, Winter Haven, FL.

The Commission met on April 25, 2015, at 4:30 p.m. at the church. A quorum was present.

The Commission meeting was called to order and opened with prayer by TE Jonathan Winfree. Rev. Barry A. "Drew" Bennett was elected chairman and Mr. Gene Lanehart was elected Secretary of the Commission. The order of Worship was reviewed and approved by the Commission. The minutes were read and approved. Commission recessed with prayer by Rev. Stan McMahan for the installation service.

The Chairman presided in the sanctuary service, which was opened with singing, prayer and Scripture reading. The sermon was preached by Rev. Barry A. "Drew" Bennett, on the topic "Remember Jesus Christ" from 2 Timothy 2:1-13.


The Chairman stated briefly the previous proceedings of the Presbytery, and pointed out the nature and importance of the ordination/installation ordinance.

The Chairman propounded the constitutional questions to the Candidate/Minister (*BCO* 21.9) and these were answered in the affirmative. The Chairman then propounded the constitutional questions to the congregation (*BCO* 21.10), and these were answered in the affirmative by the Members holding up their right hands. The Candidate then kneeled and was set apart to the holy office of the Gospel Ministry with prayer and the laying on of hands. He then rose and the Members of the Commission gave him the right hand of fellowship. The Chairman then declared that Rev. Brandon Lutz had been regularly elected and installed as Assistant Pastor of the Church.

A charge to the Assistant Pastor was delivered by Rev. Jonathan Winfree.

A charge to the Session/Congregation was delivered by Rev. Stan McMahan.

Following prayer and singing, the new Pastor pronounced the benediction. The minutes having been approved, the Benediction closed this portion of the Commission's business.
